

ILCP Instructions

To achieve a certain level on the ILCP you must meet the requirements below.

CIL level – get a 75 or above on the test

CJIL level – pass the CIL level and get a 75 or above on the mandatory and 6 electives.

If you are sitting for the Certified Institutional Locksmith (CIL) level use the form included; you do not have to fill in **Documentation of Years in Industry** or pick **Electives**.

If you are sitting for the Certified Journeyman Institutional Locksmith (CJIL) level you will need to pick electives from the list below. You must also include a copy of your proof of years in the industry with your application. (We will not issue your CJIL level until we have this documentation on file even if you pass your tests.)

Pick electives as described below:

Pick 6 electives; 1 must be from column **A** and 1 must be from column **B**. The remaining 4 can be from any column. (PICK ONLY 6)

A are Pinning system electives

B are lock brand electives

C are other hardware and related fields

CJIL retake:

- If Failed the mandatory and all six electives
Must retake mandatory and six electives

- If Failed the mandatory but passed only some electives
Must retake Mandatory and can take six electives; Any passed in addition to the six needed for the CJIL will be applied toward the CMIL level.

- If Passed the mandatory but passed only some electives (1 to 5)
Can pick up to 12 electives they have not already passed. Any electives Passed in excess of the six needed for the CJIL will be applied toward the CMIL

Check back often as new electives can be added at any time. If you are already registered for a CJIL exam and an elective that you would prefer to take becomes available contact the ILCP committee at ILAcert@gmail.net and we will change it for you up to two weeks before your sitting.
